



Church Commitment

Since the success of the *Freedom Health Ministries* is dependent on the faithful involvement of the church, the following is a summary of the minimum qualifications of the church to run the *Freedom Health Ministries* program.

- A minimum of **30 church members** who have signed up and are committed to attending and fulfilling the obligations of the Gospel and Medical Missionary training classes.
- The Gospel and Medical Missionary training classes require a commitment to the following during the duration of the 4-month program:
 - Involvement in the **entire Sabbath training class** (3 hrs on Sabbath afternoons 2 - 5pm)
 - Attendance of **1 evening seminar** per week (1.75 hrs on a weeknight from 6 - 7:45pm)
 - Involvement in **1 guest visit** per week (2 hrs)
 - Guest visits may include: in-home Bible studies, lifestyle coaching, in-home health treatments, or assistance at the health clinic.
 - Guest visits will almost always be supervised by a *Freedom Health Ministries* team member or church leader.
- All church members who sign up for the training class must be **members in good standing** and in **regular attendance**.
- The **pastor** must be an essential part of the program and must be in attendance to the majority of the training classes, seminars, as well as many guest visits as possible.
- All of the **elders** must be signed up for the training class and must meet the minimum requirements of the Gospel and Medical Missionary training classes.

Church Service: The *Freedom Health Ministries* program does not disturb or require any changes to the church's normal church service plans. The *Freedom Health Ministries* staff will be happy to be involved in the church service activities such as Sabbath school and divine service upon the church's request. Occasionally, a sermon slot may be requested in order to prepare the church for upcoming events in the ministry program.
